Minutes

The First Meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) for the academic session **2025–26** was held on **11 June 2025 at 2.00 P.M.** under the Chairmanship of **Dr. V. C. Kharode, Principal** of Bhausaheb Lahane Dnyanprakash Arts College, Pinjar, Dist. Akola.

The IQAC Coordinator welcomed all the members. The agenda items were taken up for discussion one by one, and after detailed deliberations, the following resolutions were unanimously passed.

Subject No. 1 Confirmation of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Resolution

The IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Ashok Wahurwagh, read the minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 1 May 2024. Since no corrections or suggestions were received from the members, the minutes were confirmed and approved unanimously.

Subject No. 2 To change charge of Coordinator, IQAC

Resolution

Subject No. 3: Academic Calendar and Induction Program

Resolution

Departments shall also organize research-related activities to foster innovation and critical thinking.

Subject No. 7: Student Support and Career Development**Resolution**

The IQAC resolved to strengthen student support services by organizing career guidance programmes, competitive examination coaching, placement assistance, entrepreneurship awareness programmes, Field Visits, Study Tours and skill development workshops. Special attention shall be given to improving employability, holistic and Social development of students.

Subject No. 8: Extension and Community Engagement**Resolution**

The committee resolved to organize extension and outreach programmes through NSS, various departments, and institutional cells. Activities related to environmental awareness, health, financial literacy, voter awareness, gender sensitization, and social responsibility shall be conducted regularly to promote community engagement.

Subject No. 9: Infrastructure and Digital Development**Resolution**

The IQAC resolved to improve academic infrastructure by upgrading ICT facilities, classrooms, library resources, laboratories, and campus internet connectivity. Digital administrative practices and e-governance shall also be strengthened to enhance institutional efficiency. Subject No. 10: Green Campus**Resolution**
